A statement that the complaining party has a good-faith belief that the use of the material is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law.

A statement, under penalty of perjury, that the information in the notice is accurate and that the complaining party is authorized to act on behalf of the copyright owner.

Trademark Infringement:

We take trademark infringement seriously and strive to maintain the integrity of our brand.

If you believe that your trademark rights are being infringed upon by content on our website, please send a notice of infringement to our designated Trademark Agent, including the following information:

Identification of the trademark(s) claimed to be infringed.

Identification of the content that allegedly infringes the trademark.

Contact information of the complaining party (name, address, email address, and phone number).

A statement that the complaining party has a good-faith belief that the use of the trademark is unauthorized.

A statement, under penalty of perjury, that the information in the notice is accurate and that the complaining party is authorized to act on behalf of the trademark owner.

Counter-Notice:

If your content has been removed or disabled as a result of an infringement notice, you may submit a counter-notice if you believe the removal was a mistake or misidentification.

The counter-notice should include the following:

Identification of the material that was removed or disabled and its location on our website.

A statement, under penalty of perjury, that you have a good-faith belief that the material was removed or disabled due to a mistake or misidentification.

Your consent to the jurisdiction of a federal court in the jurisdiction where your address is located (within India), or your consent to the jurisdiction of a court in the jurisdiction where your address is located (Within India).
